Come and join us for the Dresden Plate workshop. Karen Hill from Granny Quilts will be teaching us how to make a Dresden Plate the easy way. We will be making a small wall hanging that can be completed or nearly completed during the workshop.

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

Basic sewing supplies including sewing machine, thread, scissors, etc. 1/2-yard background fabric 1 charm pack 30-degree Dresden ruler (optional)

Point turner (something to turn points to the outside such as a "purple thang") Roxanne glue



Winter days are the perfect time to make plans for this years' challenge project! Create your project from repurposed textiles and save fabric from the landfill. Here are a few ideas to get you started:

- Have any orphan blocks? Create a quilt of your own design or use them to make a tote bag or embellish a garment.
- Have you saved those ends you trimmed off all those flying geese? Turn them into mini squares and make your own design for a table runner.
- Shop the consignment stores for fabric or garments to embellish with fabric from your stash.
- Have vintage linens but don't know what to do with them? Create a small whole cloth quilt from a tablecloth or use them to make quilt blocks.


