Co-chairs work with the chair for the 2024 quilt show, learning the responsibilities for each committee. They will assume the chair position for the 2026 quilt show. A brief description of the responsibilities for the remaining positions follows:

• **Decorations:** Plans and gets supplies for decorating the outside and inside of the quilt area using the theme of the show.

- **Quilt labels:** Design and creates small fabric label given to quilt owner when they pick up their quilt. These keepsake labels often have the show theme and date.
- Hanging quilts: Works with setting up of frames, gathers, and brings supplies for the hanging of large and small quilts. Lines up helpers to put up and take down. Works with check in/out person to take down and check out.
- **Quilt Mom:** Responsible for the raffle quilt once it is finished. Design raffle tickets, have them printed, and distribute to members. Arrange for quilt to travel to various places where it can be on display and tickets sold. Track and manage the ticket sales and money.
- **Housekeeping:** Keeping the quilt show tidy! Emptying trash, checking bathrooms for supplies needed, cleaning up spills etc.
- **Parking:** Designating parking areas for vendors and spectators. Arranging transportation to door for those needing extra assistance.
